Hi there

It's costume time.

I am not necessarily looking for parents to go out and buy outfits, I would rather we borrowed items. Please ask around and help each other out. Especially as I have left the list until the last moment this year.

The play is about Cowboys and Indians so the obvious costumes are:

Goodies: blue jeans, white t-shirt, brown cowboy hat, brown cowboy waistcoat, red necktie/ bootlace, holster and brown chaps and cowboy boots if possible. (Chaps and cowboy boots are optional)

Baddies: black jeans, Black t-shirt, black cowboy hat, black cowboy waistcoat, black necktie/ bootlace, holster and black chaps and cowboy boots if possible. (Chaps and cowboy waistcoat are optional)

Indians: White or flesh-coloured leggings. Indian costume- if you have one, or can borrow one. If not we will make one out of crepe paper. Head dresses have already been made.

Townfolk: Blue jeans, checked shirt and neckerchief (any colour but black) and cowboy boots if possible.

Horse: brown leggings and white or brown socks. – we have made the head.

Undertakers: Black blazers, black top hat, black trousers and black shoes as well as a white shirt, black tie or cravat.

Saloon Girls: Either a dark leotard or swimming costume. Skirts have already been made. Footwear should be sandals. They can wear a headband with a bow on if they like too. Could they also have a cloth as a prop for wiping tables with.

Children: Blue jeans or dungarees with childlike t-shirt and glittery cowboy hat.

Barbers: White shirt, dickie bow (any colour) and Jeans.

Chip: Blue jeans, white shirt, waist coat and bow tie. White knee length apron.

Billie-Jo: Blue jeans, white t-shirt, pink t-shirt, white cowboy hat, white cowboy waistcoat, red neckerchief, pink neckerchief, white neckerchief, cowboy boots, holster and plastic pistol.

Dr. Cornelius: White doctors coat, blue jeans, cowboy boots or black/ brown shoes. Brown cowboy hat.

Rooster: Blue jeans, checked shirt, brown cowboy hat, brown cowboy waistcoat, cowboy boots.

Seth and Amos: Blue jeans, blue t-shirt, brown cowboy waist coat, brown cowboy hats, walking stick, cowboy boots or shoes and a pipe.

Initially, I would like you to source a costume for your own child first, but if you have an item that you think would be appropriate for another character then please send it in.

All items sent in should have your child's name on it clearly, then I can ensure its safe return.
